

Kim M. Jackson and Jared W. Heald prevail on OCGA 9-11-68 Motion for Fees Following Successful Trial Verdict

Rome, Georgia's largest CPA firm at trial in March. Following the trial, **Kim M. Jackson** and **Jared W. Heald** moved for attorney fees and expenses associated with defending the second trial based on the failure of Plaintiff to recover at least 75% of a pre-trial offer, as permitted by OCGA 9-11-68. The Plaintiffs opposed the motion arguing that the offer of settlement had been made in bad faith. The Court held a hearing in May of 2015, and issued its written order in December of 2015, granting the CPA firm's motion and awarding over \$100,000 in attorney fees and expenses.
